BSET ANNUAL MEETING 2026 ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

A summary of the guidelines follows:

- The abstract must consist of four paragraphs entitled: Background, Methods, Results, Conclusions
- The abstracts are to be submitted **as text only** (no tables or images)
- The text should be no longer than 250 words
- Since the abstract will be judged anonymously, **the text must not reveal the institutional affiliation**
- We will only consider abstracts from practising doctors, medical students, and allied health professionals working in a medical institution.
- Abstracts submitted by medical students, AHPs and trainees should have a Consultant sponsor
- Authors should declare prior/pending presentations at other meetings, and any accepted abstract publications, on submission. If an abstract is presented at more than one conference, authors must accept only one offer to publish the abstract text. This should not apply to full publication.
- Please ensure that the abstract has been seen and agreed by all of the named authors before submission. All of the authors have a responsibility to ensure that the data submitted are accurate, are not extrapolated and fairly represents the presentation to be given at the Meeting

Abstracts that are selected for prize presentation are published in the EJVES.

By submitting your abstract for publication, you agree for the European Journal of Vascular and Endovascular Surgery to publish it and it cannot be published elsewhere. Publication of the abstract does not preclude the author from publishing a full length paper on the same research in EJVES or elsewhere at a later date.

All areas of the form must be completed and failure to do so will result in the form being **rejected**. It is your responsibility to ensure that the information you provide is correct. BSET cannot be held responsible for failure to notify successful authors of abstract acceptance if the contact information is incorrect.
